# Night of Spectacles, Design Competition

The Georgia Lions Lighthouse Foundation has held **Night of Spectacles, an eyewear fashion event** for the past four years. Each year, fashion designers and fashion students have created fashion pieces from recycled eyewear, which were auctioned off. The funds raised support the Georgia Lions Lighthouse Foundation's vision services program for uninsured Georgians. This year we are holding our third annual "Project Runway®" style competition for up and coming fashion designers as part of **Night of Spectacles**. Complete this application form letting us know how many glasses and lenses you will need and submit a resume if desired.

## All designers selected for competition to be featured in a charity fashion show will:

- Be introduced to fashion influencers in the Atlanta community
- Receive 2 tickets to the event (one for designer, one for model\*)
- Compete to win a \$1000 scholarship
- Have a chance to interview with various media outlets to promote design
- Be given professional photo prints and digital files of design and fashion show
- Display and auction off work for the event's 400 guests in a runway show

Applications may be submitted by fashion students and designers. All designs submitted to the fashion challenge must:

- Use eyewear frames or lenses to create fashion with a vision. Lenses and frames must be used in 40 % of design.
- Be able to be worn by a model to walk down a runway.\*
- Be donated to the Georgia Lions Lighthouse Foundation for fundraising purposes.
- Applicants may enter as a team of two, in which case the scholarship will be split

\*Some models will be designated from the Atlanta community. Those who choose to make dresses to fit these models may have a greater chance of being selected, but designers can choose to recruit their own models and make clothing to fit accordingly.

Dates of importance:

- January 10, 2012 - All completed applications due by 5:00 p.m.
- February 19, 2012– Design sketches due to the Lighthouse office in Decatur for preliminary judging
- March 31, 2012 – Pictures of finished dresses submitted to Lighthouse\*

April 28, 2012 – Night of Spectacles, eyewear fashion show and competition

\*Early completion is encouraged. Submitting a finished dress to the Lighthouse office in Chamblee before the deadline may make it eligible for publicity opportunities, such as an appearance on a local television show in Atlanta or featuring the design in other promotional materials leading up to the event.

Between 12-20 designs will be chosen to participate in the fashion show. Discounted tickets to the event will be made available for student's families/friends and for students whose designs are not selected.
